Social Committee Charter

Purpose

The purpose of this Committee is to advise and consult with the Association management and Board of Directors on the type, content, planning, implementation and evaluation of recreation events, classes, activities and social functions sponsored by Northwood II Community Association. Additionally, the Committee may be requested to conduct studies, provide recommendations and other special projects as assigned by the Board of Directors.

Function

- (1) Suggest, plan and assist in the implementation of appropriate recreation events for the enjoyment of Association members.
- (2) Recruit and organize volunteers for events as necessary. Additionally, Committee members should endeavor to volunteer their time at Association events.
- (3) Listen to and consider suggestions and concerns of Northwood II residents regarding the recreation program.
- (4) Propose policies to the Board of Directors related to the use of recreational facilities, facility Rules and Regulations, rental policies and other relevant recreation issues.
- (5) When requested, make recommendations to the Board of Directors related to capital improvements concerning recreational equipment for Northwood II facilities.
- (6) All recommendations made by the Committee are to be submitted in writing for consideration by the Board of Directors. Recommendations made by the Committee shall not be considered Association policy unless approved and adopted by resolution of the Board of Directors.

Meetings

The Social Committee shall meet as necessary, but not less than once every quarter. Committee Members shall endeavor to attend as many meetings as possible.

Membership

Members of the Committee must be Members of the Association. The Committee shall consist of as many Members as desired by the Board of Directors, but not less than three (3) Members. The Committee shall have a Chair and Vice Chair as appointed by the Committee. The Chair and Vice Chair shall be elected by a majority of the members of the Committee at the first meeting of each calendar year.

Term

Each member shall serve at the pleasure of the Board of Directors.
